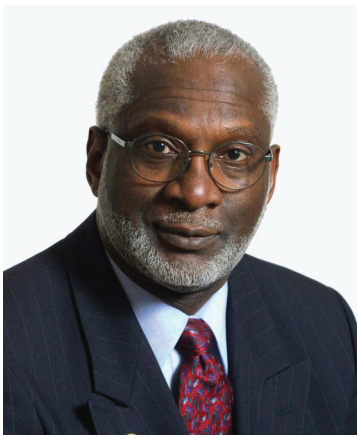

Keynote address by special guest: David Satcher, M.D., Ph.D.



David Satcher, M.D., Ph.D. is director of The Satcher Health Leadership Institute at the Morehouse School of Medicine. The Institute's programs reflect his demonstrated track record in improving public health policy and his commitment to eliminating health disparities for underserved groups, such as minorities and the poor, and shedding light on neglected issues including mental and sexual health.

Dr. Satcher was sworn in as the 16th Surgeon General of the United States in 1998. He also served as Assistant Secretary for Health for the Department of Health and Human Services—making him the second person in history to have held both positions simultaneously. He also served as director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and administrator of the Toxic Substances and Disease Registry.

With over 40 honorary degrees and numerous distinguished honors, Dr. Satcher serves on the Board of Directors of Johnson & Johnson, MetLife, and the CDC Foundation among others.
